Children's bags

For those children coming to school on a bike we recommend they have a haversack type bag on their back whilst cycling, so they are hands free. This must then be left in a carrier bag on the handle bars of the bike during the day. All bags will be checked on Monday by staff as a number of large bags have crept back into school.
