

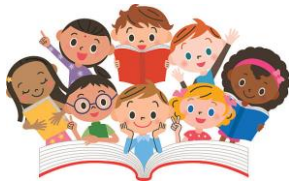

Swindon SENDi & Alternative Provision Strategy Consultation

The SENDi & AP Strategy is a key document that outlines Swindon's vision for SEND over the coming years against the Local Authority's strategic priorities.

Due to our recent success with implementing the OFSTED improvements, this document will stand in place for 5 years, at which point the consultation process must begin again.

The document will include local and national data to provide a picture of Swindon SEND, so that it can be determined how we move forward to improve the

outcomes for children and young people with SEND. We will also be looking at the Alternative Provisions available in Swindon, and so would love to hear your thoughts on that too!

Over the next few months a consultation will take place to ensure the new version of this document is co-produced ready for publication in April 2023.

In order to ensure this document is co-produced, we will be attending a range of events to gain the opinions of both colleagues and community members.
