


## Types of Maps


### An Aerial View


Maps are usually drawn from an **aerial view**. We can look at **aerial** photographs to see the main **physical** and **human** features of places. **Aerial** photos are photos taken by aircraft or other flying objects, e.g. drones. A satellite photo is taken from a satellite in space.



### Key Features

Key features of maps include: a title, a **compass rose**, **symbols**, a **key** and different colours for important things, such as green for forests and blue for rivers.


- ### Key Facts
- The United Kingdom is made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
  - The official flag is the Union Flag, nicknamed the Union Jack. It was designed to include the English, Scottish, Welsh and Northern Irish flags.
  - Many small islands belong to the UK, such as the **Isle of Wight**.
  - The currency in the UK is the pound sterling.
  - England has the largest population (number of people who live there) in the UK. The population of the UK is around 64 million!
