A priest walked by and did nothing.


A Levite walked by and did nothing.



The Islamic Qur'an

The Qur'an has only one version, written in Arabic.

The holy book for Islam is the Qur'an. Muslims believe it is 'the word of God'. Muslim beliefs and practices are rooted in the Qur'an.


