Communication Language & Literacy •Introduce a storyline or narro

Learning Goals:

- Can listen attentively
- Can follow instructions involving several ideas or actions
- Children develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events

Personal, Social and Emotional Development •Tries to resolve conflicts with other children, e.g. finding a compromise

Learning Goals:

- Children are confident to try new activities and say why they like some activities more than others
- Children play cooperatively, taking turns with others

Physical Development

- Form recognisable letters, most of which are formed correctly
 Practices some safety measures independently (- holding scissors)
 Learning Goals:
- -Know the importance for good health of physical exercise and a healthy diet.
- Children handle equipment & tools effectively, including pencils for writing

Learning Goal: Children read and understand simple sentences

Literacy

Segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together
Reading and writing activities both indoors and outdoors
Begins to read words and simple sentences.
Writes own name and other things such as labels, captions Learning Goals:

- Children write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others.

- They also read some common 'Tricky' words

Mathematics •Compare & order two items by weight & capacity. •Create & recreate patterns & build models. •Use language related to time

Learning Goals:

- Children solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing
- -Children use quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answers

Understanding the World ·Looks closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change Learning Goals

- They make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur, and talk about changes

- They talk about the features of their own immediate environment and how environments might vary from one another
- Children recognise that a range of technology is used in places such as homes and schools

Expressive Arts and Design •Build a repertoire of songs

and dances •Experiment with different textures

Learning Goals

- Children use what they have learnt about media and materials in original ways, thinking about uses and purposes

-They represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories
