KS1 SATs will be taking place during weeks four and five of this term (15thth-26th May 2023). The children will still have a normal school day and will be unaware that they are undertaking pieces of work that will then be assessed. Please make sure that children arrive as promptly as possible and have had a good breakfast on these days. Please continue to work through the revision books provided with your child. If you have any questions about this then please do not hesitate to ask.
